
This report shows participants’ satisfaction with the Youth Exchange, both on the thematic part of the youth exchange and the logistical part of it. They had to rank some questions from 1-6 (1 being very bad, 6 being very good), also answer some open questions and assess a learning environment on a scale.

On the last day of the project, the final evaluation was organized, where participants anonymously evaluated all aspects related to the project. The evaluation showed that participants were satisfied with all phases/aspects of the project implementation.

The participants reported an increase of knowledge about green entrepreneurship, if before the project 48% reported an average and 29.6% low knowledge of the topic, at the end, 37% reported very high knowledge and 55.66% good knowledge of green entrepreneurship.


Before the Youth Exchange how would you rate your level of knowledge about green entrepreneurship?


After the Youth Exchange how would you rate your level of knowledge about green entrepreneurship?


How satisfied were you with accommodation?


How satisfied were you with the working room/s?

59.3% of participants rated accommodation as Very Good, while 37% as Good.

66.7% of participants also rated working rooms with the Very High score and 29.6% with Good.

As for the food, 33.3% evaluated as Good, 25.9% as normal, 18.5% as Very Good and the rest 11-11% were less satisfied with food.

63% of participants were very much satisfied with the preparation of the Youth Exchange. As for the the most important and useful programme part(ss), participants named:

"The group works gave the countries a chance to integrate more"


"Activities and role-plays about environmental problems, circular economy, green business cases, etc"

"How to communicate my ideas in better way, and I learnd a lot about Local traditions"

"You need to step out of your comfort zone"

"More about ecology, green choice, other cultures. I learnt a lot on green businesses"

"Learning by doing is the best approach to make this world better place to live for us youngsters and next generations! :) I increased my baseline knowledge on green initiatives and economical ideas in general"
