ABOUT PROJECT:

PARTICIPANTS:

Participants aged 18 to 28, no age limit for group leader. In total 33 youth in the project (2 leaders from Curacao).

GOALS

Hate incidents targeting migrants, refugees and other ethnic and religious minorities are at the center of a recent conferences organized by the OSCE ODIHR, COE, UN and many other international or local institutions.

ACTIVITES

Non-formal educational tools such as role play, workshops, study visits, handy craft exercises will be used during the project, carefully chosen by qualified youth workers and young beneficiaries. It is noteworthy, that each activity has specific aim relevant to the main aim and objectives of the project.
