

**Report of assessment
“Bouquet of Cultures”
Erasmus+ Youth Exchange
Willemstad, Curacao
6-14 November 2018**

This report shows to what extent the participants increased their knowledge on three core topics during their participation in youth “Bouquet of Cultures”. The topics which were focused on during the project are following: Erasmus+ Programme and opportunities under it, discrimination and interculturalism.

28 participants from Curacao, Georgia, Portugal and Moldova filled the assessment papers in the beginning and then at the end of the project. Group leaders gave clear instructions on how to fill. Assessment papers were anonymous and were filled individually. Answers were scored from 0 to 5 (0 – no answer, not correct answer, 5 – fully correct answer).

Assessment report showed the increase of average knowledge on Erasmus+ programme from 1.6 to 3.7. Participants also improved their knowledge on Life Long Learning Program and the eight key competencies by 2.5 point (Post 3.1- Pre 0.6), as well as their knowledge was significantly increased on European Voluntary Service Program (from point 0.9 to point 4.0).

Assessment report also revealed positive change on understanding what is stereotype and how it is formed, as well as what discriminated groups live in their respective communities. Pre assessment showed that approx. 36% of participants didn’t have clear idea what is stereotype (point 0 and point 1), while at the final assessment 100% could give definition of term (point 3, 4 and point 5). As for the next question to name discriminated group, during pre-assessment test 40% of participants couldn’t name or hardly could name one discriminated group (point 0, 1 and 2), while on the post-assessment test all participants (100%) could name at least two discriminated group in their communities.

In the next part of the assessment, knowledge on interculturalism topic was increased from point 1.3 to point 3.9 and lastly, on the benefits of multiculturalism, the knowledge was increased from point 1.8 to 4.1.

To summarize assessment results, “Bouquet of Cultures” project could significantly increase participants’ knowledge on the main topics of youth exchange: Erasmus+ Programme and opportunities under it, discrimination and interculturalism.
