#### Report of VISIT to TV - Direct Media Curação

On October 18, 2021, one day before finalizing the 'Green Choice' project – participants/representatives of all participating countries: Chris Janzen, Arian Hosepha Arian, Salome Gvelesiani and Karla Blažević got a spot on the national tv morning show 'MAINTA' - the most popular TV channel and one of the most-watched TV shows. In the show for 15 minutes they talked about Erasmus+, the ongoing and upcoming projects and among them about "**Play for Change**" and also gave information on how to become part of the "Play for Change" youth exchanges.

Arian started to introduce the Erasmus+ Programme and its' goal, as well as Curação NGO Stichting Felis and the goal of the organization, that it aims to create a better life for the kids in the city of Otrobanda. He also shared the story of how Gerda Petersen started the organization and how she introduced Erasmus+ on the island of Curação.

Chris continued to mention what is youth exchange and European Solidarity Corps and the goal of participating in such programes. He talked about his experience volunteering in the Netherlands for 4 months and what he learned about his experience.

Karla from NGO Kreaktiva Croatia talked about the current YE 'green choice'. She mentioned the activities that we did and the reason we decided to choose this topic for this Youth Exchange. She also talked about the business initiatives every country created that they can implement when they get home.

Salome from NGO InoChange Georgia finalized by explaining to the audience what Erasmus+ is and what it provides not only to the individuals but to local communities. And because InoChange has been partnering with Felis Foundation for some time now. She stressed the point of how such international projects positively change our minds and open the horizons and that it really bring changes for both individuals and communities.






#### A Joint Zoom Meeting between partners of three projects


#### Online APV as Finland could not travel
